



**2003**  
Construction begins on Nebraska Orthopaedic Hospital, as the MRI and Physical & Occupational Therapy clinics open.



**2003**  
Nebraska Orthopaedic Associates, which has grown to seven physicians, rebrands as NebOrtho.



**2010**  
Nebraska Orthopaedic Hospital adds Clarkson Emergency and four (4) additional operating rooms.



**May 12, 2017**  
Nebraska Orthopaedic Hospital & OrthoWest come together under a single name - OrthoNebraska.

**March 2020**  
Virtual care services are implemented to meet the needs of patients.

**July 2020**  
OrthoNebraska opens an orthopedic urgent care & clinic inside Think Whole Person Healthcare.



**October 2021**  
OrthoNebraska opens its second largest location in Elkhorn, which includes 16 exam rooms, two (2) procedure rooms, radiology services, and 9,500+ square feet of physical & hand therapy space.

**1938**  
Dr. William Hamsa opens a small private orthopedic practice to care for patients in eastern Nebraska.

**1980**  
Drs. Michael Walsh, Randall Neumann & David Brown open the Sports Medicine Center.

**1995**  
The Sports Medicine Center joins Methodist Physicians' Clinic.

**2002**  
The Methodist Orthopedic Physicians make a shift to private practice and are renamed OrthoWest.



**2004**  
The area's first hospital dedicated to the complete care of the orthopedic patient opens - Nebraska Orthopaedic Hospital. Founding physicians include Drs. Charles Burt, Steve Hagan, Kirk Hutton, & William Singer.



**2014**  
OrthoWest & NebOrtho combine practices to form the area's largest orthopedic practice.



**September 2019**  
The hospital and clinic transition to a single electronic medical record system.

**September 2020**  
OrthoNebraska expands the hospital to house all twelve (12) operating rooms under one roof.



**September 2022**  
OrthoNebraska opens a stand-alone orthopedic urgent care, clinic, and physical & hand therapy clinic off Interstate 80 in Council Bluffs, IA.
